Our program was rebranded back in 2015 from Future Educators of America at which point we began work to develop standards and curriculum.

Schools adopt our curriculum to quickly set up a new program, alongside chapters and all the activities that come with having access to a career and technical student organization (CTSO).

Introduced in the summer of 2024, Educators Rising launched its assessment platform—Educators Rising Lesson Assessments—as an add-on component to our Curriculum.

Aligned closely with the core lessons in the Educators Rising Curriculum, lesson assessments provide teachers flexibility in which types of assessment questions to assign for each lesson.

This new platform will enhance the student experience and save teachers time and effort.



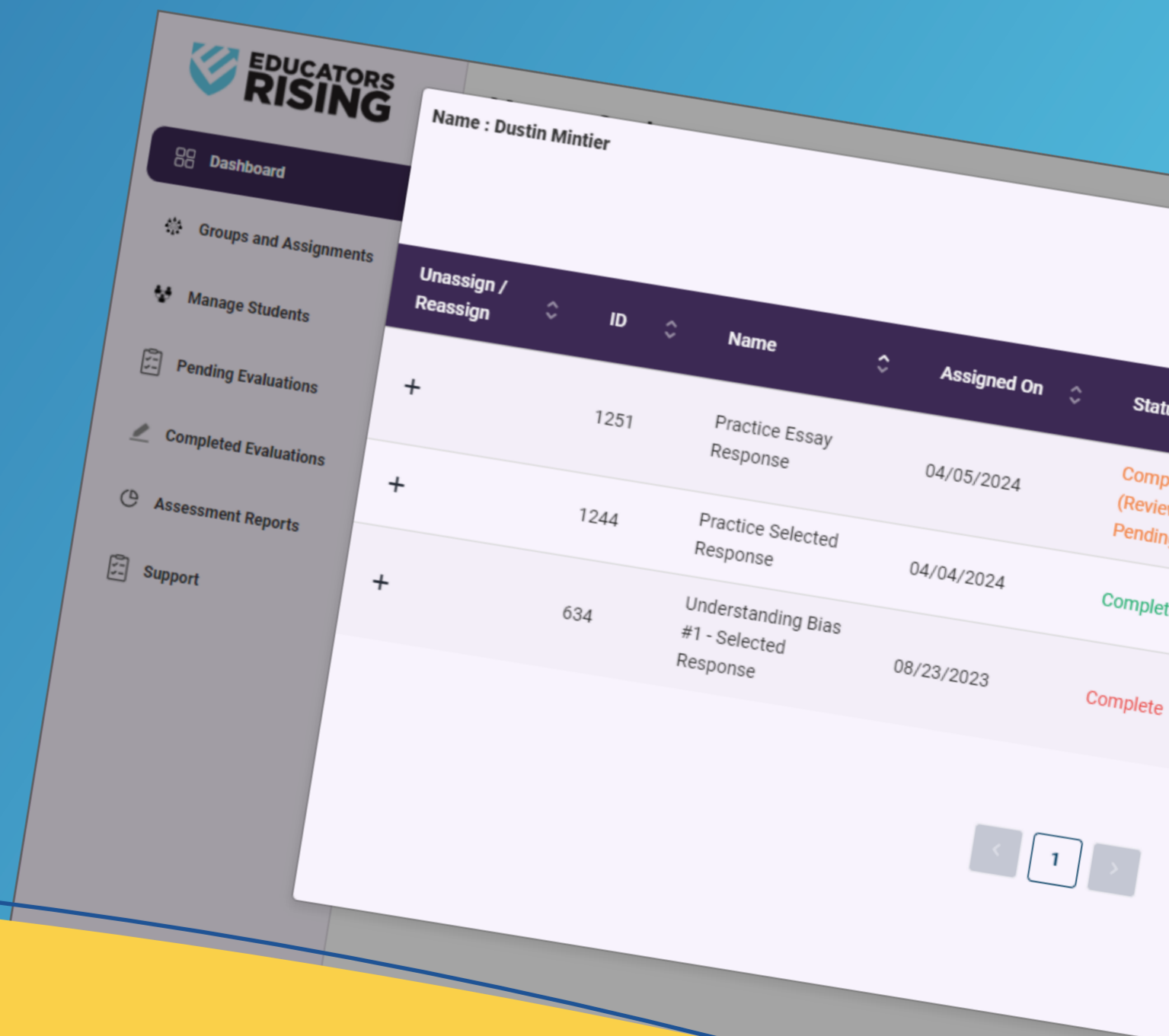
# Easy to Use, Saves You Time

We recognize that good teaching is more than just sharing content with students. Assessments are now joined with our curriculum to ensure that students are mastering the content aligned with our standards.

Educators Rising Lesson Assessments save teachers time by cutting out the assessment-development tasks that go with instruction.

Use the teacher's administrative area of our platform to choose assessment options and monitor student progress.

Students will find navigating in the system easy and seamless. Unfinished assessments are populated at the top of their assigned list. Students can always log back into the system to review past assessment results.



# Designed to Help Students

As electronic learning management tools have evolved, they have provided options to include **feedback on quizzes and exams** for students.

Our platform offers students **two types of feedback for selective answer options**: information on distractors used and a rationale for why missed answers do not qualify.

Since we are working with future educators who will write their own assessments for their students, **we wanted them to see how items are written** by including rationales on why an answer is or is not correct. This provides an individualized level of feedback that may otherwise be difficult to give to each of your students.

Our selective answer questions come in a **variety of difficulty levels**, ranked using Webb's Depth of Knowledge (Levels 1-3). This ensures we get beyond surface learning and approach **deeper levels of student understanding of concepts**.

The Educators Rising Lesson Assessments include **short-answer questions** for each lesson in addition to **selective answer questions**.

Teachers can opt to assign either version of each lesson assessment, or both. To ease the required teacher grading of short-answer questions, we include either a **4- or 6-point rubric** for each short answer prompt.



# Designed to Grow Superstars

We went back to why we first developed our curriculum—we wanted to **help raise the quality of Grow Your Own programs** while simultaneously **assisting schools get started** without the months or years it takes to develop their own curriculum.

In this spirit, our Educators Rising Lesson Assessments were designed to help direct more of a teacher leader's energy upon student instruction and support while providing a necessary and needed component in teaching and learning with high-quality assessments.

Just like our Curriculum, our Lesson Assessments are **built upon the same teaching standards** that we co-developed with national partners, aligned with both the **National Board Teaching Standards** and **inTASC standards**.
